

Kenyon adopts seller/server ordinance

The Kenyon City Council voted Tuesday to adopt a mandatory alcohol seller/server training ordinance that will go into effect Wednesday.

The Kenyon City Council voted Tuesday to adopt a mandatory alcohol seller/server training ordinance that will go into effect Wednesday.

The ordinance will require all sellers and servers of alcohol to complete a responsible beverage service training course annually before selling or serving liquor in Kenyon.

Mandatory alcohol seller/server training ordinances have been proven to reduce alcohol access to minors and over-service of adults, according to Goodhue County Chemical Health Initiative. The ordinance will not apply to 3.2 beer licenses.
