I. Phillip motioned to approve the agenda, and Brenda seconded that motion. The motion was carried.

II. Phillip motioned to approve the secretary's minutes from May's meeting, and Brenda seconded the motion. The motion was passed.

III. The financial report was approved by Glenn, and Phillip seconded it. The motion was passed. The only change in the financial report was the expenditure for postage for the graduation postcards. That cost was \$28.00, which leaves \$1716.97 in our account.

### **IV. Old Business**

#### **a. Sticker Shock Campaign**

This is an event that the CFHS student group could participate in before Homecoming and/or Halloween. Kenyon's group received front-page recognition in local newspapers. Red Wing students will be putting on the stickers in the fall.

#### **b. Seller/Server Training**

The training will be held on 6/22/2010, at the RW Library. Seventeen individuals have signed up for the training, but no Cannon Falls establishments have. Some of the topics that will be discussed are the impact that a violation has on insurance and the criminal and civil liability an establishment has.

#### **c. Summer Events**

Evan will be Howie, and Phillip will act as Howie's handler. The line-up for the parade is at the HS around 10:00 am on July 4<sup>th</sup>. Because our mode of transportation is questionable at this time, Kathy will check with Stephanie Fox, the parade coordinator, to see if we can partner with another float/parade entry.

The first Movie and Music will be on August 2<sup>nd</sup>, and the CF Community Band will be playing that night. In lieu of an August meeting, we thought we could do something at that event. We will discuss this idea at our July meeting. Please bring ideas for Monday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>!

Fall Sports Registration will be on Monday, August 9<sup>th</sup>, at the High School. Stacy will check with Bucky about the FYI cards, as well as a speaker (a former athlete, perhaps) who would be willing to talk about underage drinking and/or about the CHI.

Stacy will ask Bucky or the Police Department about a letter that was inserted in the National Night Out packet. The council thought it would be a helpful addition to the information that the neighborhood hosts receive.

#### **V. Council Structure:**

- a. Because of the resignations of Bucky, Greg, and Micki, there are vacant positions on the council that need to be filled. It would be nice to get more community members involved. Some ideas to get the word out include the following: an ad on Channel 12, announcing the open positions on the website, putting together an insert for church bulletins regarding the council and who might be interested, and putting an article in The Beacon. In the article, recognizing the resigning members would also be a nice gesture.
- b. Stacy suggested that we realign the structure of the council. One of the methods that was suggested is to rotate leadership roles. That way, no one has to be in a role for more than one year. Whoever is the vice-chair one year would naturally become the chair the following year.
- c. For the next few months, council members will volunteer to run the monthly meetings. Phil volunteered to run the July meeting, and we'll go from there for the September meeting. (The August meeting may be at Movies and Music.)
- d. Current council members are asked to think of community members who would be an asset for our council. Please bring names to next month's meeting. We hope to have all sectors represented in the next few months. Invite interested people to next month's meeting.
