

**Kenyon-Wanamingo CHI Council

**TREASURER AND ACCOUNT UPDATE- Presented by Nancy Benrud (Council Treasurer)**

Our current balance is \$2512.50. One bill of \$23.50 was paid out to Grimsrud Publishing for a holiday ad shared with the Zumbrota and Goodhue CHI Councils.

**KEY BUSINESS ITEMS:**

**Holiday Ad Discussion: we had a joint ad during the holiday season with the Zumbrota and Goodhue Councils.**

**Seller/Server & Social Host Ordinance Discussion:**

We had lengthy discussion on the next steps in this area. Currently Stacy and other members of the CHI Staff are meeting one to one with liquor licensees to discuss the seller/server ordinance. Most business owners have been very receptive. The next step will be to send letters to the liquor licensees in Kenyon and then follow-up with a one-on-one meeting with each owner/manager to discuss the ordinance and provide them with information on the Minnesota-AST on-line training program. Then it will need to be presented to the City Council for approval. Lee attends the city council meetings and can bring this to the meeting. In Wanamingo, the social host ordinance will need to be presented to the city council. Dan will present the social host ordinance in Wanamingo. Exact timeframes were not determined. Dan felt that Goodhue County will be very receptive to passing both ordinances. Next month, Stacy

will go through an action plan outlining this process. We reviewed a few newspaper articles that have been in local newspapers on the ordinances.

Dan shared a thank you that was received by the council from the KW Cheerleaders. The thank you was for advertising in the sports programs and supporting the golf tournament.

### **Upcoming Events:**

#### **Snow Week:** February 14-18

The week of February 7<sup>th</sup>, the SADD Chapter will have public service announcements during the 4 home sports events that week. They will also pass out SADD materials and CHI materials at these events. Missy suggested a 5<sup>th</sup> quarter event after the basketball game on Friday, February 11. This would be for 7-9<sup>th</sup> graders. Missy will contact Jason Nurnberg to see if the SADD group would be interested in assisting with this. It would be to have snacks and play Minute to Win It games.

We were informed that Katie Sokoloski is interested in being the SADD student representative for the CHI Council.

**Conferences:** Exact dates were not known. Stacy suggested having a slideshow presentation at conferences regarding underage drinking. Stacy will obtain the dates of conferences to look into this further. It was also suggested that Jeopardy could be played while parents are waiting for their conference.

**Education Foundation Carnival:** March 26<sup>th</sup>. It was suggested that Howie could be at the carnival.

**Sleigh and Cutter Parade:** February 26<sup>th</sup>. The CHI could possibly participate in this event also.

### **COUNTY CHI UPDATE:**

Stacy provided information on a bill in both the House and Senate to ban K-2. Hopefully this will be passed by June of this year.

Stacy shared information on Ivory Wave which is a synthetic form of cocaine.

Stacy shared that there was a mailing to the Faith Sector providing a directory of resources and crisis numbers in Goodhue County. This info is on the CHI website. It was also suggested to provide a copy of this to all members.
