- Minutes from the April 2011 meeting. Rose Weber motioned to accept the minutes. Karen Hodgman seconded the motion. Chairman called for the motion. Board members approved the motion.
- Treasurers report Gary Selness. In April 2011 the total amount in the check book was \$2, 088.25. Bill for Frisbees in the amount of \$93.84 was paid (this was Zumbrota share with the other CHI Councils). Balance on May 9, 2011 is \$1,994.41. Board members approved the Treasurers report.
- CHI Scholarships was discussed. Chairman Gene Leifeld met with ZM-High School Counselor Angie Hunstad. There are no applications this year.
- Zumbrota participated in the Drug Take Back program on 4/30. It was a great success and the Zumbrota location collected the most in the county. We will plan on doing the event on an annual basis.
- Chairman discussed the Family Collaborative. Stacy Larson informed members that in April the collaborative approved additional funding for the councils. Funds will be distributed to the councils sometime in the near future.
- Discussion on CHI Bake sale is scheduled for Saturday June 18, 2011. Chairman checked with City Hall there are no additional or extra costs. The Bake sale will begin at 0730 hours that morning. There will be muffins, cinnamon rolls, cookies, and orange juice available. Members of the council will each bake 3 dozen bake goods to sell.
- Covered Bridge parade is on Saturday June 18, 2011. Annie Idler (SAAD) has six students are interested in participating in the parade. She will check with them to get a commitment from someone to be Howie for the parade. Rose mentioned that we could use her truck again this year.
- Graduation 2011 ad options were discussed. Karen Hodgman motioned to accept option 1. Brian Hefner seconded the motion. Chairman called for the question. Board members approved the motion. CHI Zumbrota will share the costs with the Kenyon-Wanamingo and Goodhue councils.
