January 10, 2011 Minutes

Chairman Gene Leifeld called the meeting to order at 1700 hours.

- Minutes from December 2010 meeting were reviewed. Rose Weber motioned to approve the December minutes. Marlene Witts seconded the motion. Chairman called for the question. Board members approved the motion.
- Agenda there additions to agenda items. Recruiting Student representatives from ZM-High School SAAD group. Chairman will contact ZM-High School. Gary Selness approved the agenda. Rose Weber seconded the motion. Chairman called for the question. Board members approved the motion.
- Treasurers' Gary Selness report. Balance on December 1, 2010 \$2,268.56. Check in the amount of \$23.50 was written to Grimsrud Publishing. This amount was for the holiday ad that was sponsored by Zumbrota, Kenyon-Wanamingo, and Goodhue CHI councils. The current balance is \$2245.06. Don Buck motioned to accept the treasurers' report. - Stacy Larson discussed Seller/Server ordinance and Social Host ordinance. Stacy is in the process of discussing the ordinances throughout the county. Joanne Pohl is working with Scott McNurlin to present to the county board. Stacy sent out letters to the 8 liquor establishments in the county/township and is planning to meet one-on-one with each to discuss the Seller/Server ordinance along with the Minnesota-AST program. It has been requested that this gets on the agenda for the April 2011 Goodhue County Commissioners' meeting Sheriff Scott McNurlin will address the county board on Social Host/Seller Server ordinances.
- Gary Selness explained that he has contacted Zumbrota Liquor and spoke with owner Deb Larson on Seller/Servers. Deb explained that she has on line training for her employees at this time. Gary will be contacting the other liquor businesses' in Zumbrota.
- There was discussion on Students Representatives' for CHI. Stacy has created a flyer and will email that to Chairman Gene Leifeld.
- Parent-Teacher Student conferences are scheduled for Monday March 7, 2011/Thursday March 10, 2011 at ZM-Schools. There will be a newsletter and CHI handouts available for parents and students.
- Discussion on CHI Game Sunday scheduled for Sunday February 27, 2011 at United Redeemer Church. The Chairman will contact the Dairy Queen, McDonalds, and Bowling Alley for certificates prizes for student participants that afternoon. Discussion on games. Jeopardy will be available that afternoon with other board games with Wii games.

- Cannon Falls CHI will have their meeting on Monday January 17, 2011 at First English Lutheran Church in Cannon Falls at 1900 hours. Other CHI Councils are welcome to attend.
- Discussed having a bake sale during the Covered Bridge Days as a fundraiser for the CHI. An option would be to have a table setup outside the City Hall Saturday morning when the run and pottery sale are active. We would start around 7:30 and run through the morning. Another option was to offer water and orange juice for the runners in the morning. We would display the CHI Banner and hand out newsletters from the council at the event.
