- Sticker Shock Campaign 2010. Stacy brought with a poster which is in the shape of stop sign, this is the poster that will be displayed at businesses' participating in the campaign.

- Stacy informed board members Goodhue County CHI will be getting new CHI T-Shirts to members. All present gave their shirt sizes to Stacy and the order will be placed.

- Discussion on Take it To the Box Program. This program allows families to safely dispose of prescription drugs. Karen Hodgman informed members that one of the problems is that young people have easy access to these types of drugs. Certain types of schedule need to taken to an incinerator which is in Illinois. Discussion on grants there are none available at this time. CHI Board members will continue with more ideas to pursue this program.

- Joann Pohl Goodhue County CHI is considering pursuing a county wide Social Hosts Ordinance. There will be more information at a later date
